7. Training and Development and dissemination of knowledge for students of second party and affiliated colleges and employees of both the organizations.
8. Clinedify Research Institute would work with incubation centres / innovation cells of second party (Case to case basis), to formulate the business cases and data collection process from various industry and academic bodies that are associated with the second party and mutual agreement.
9. Cooperation between both parties would be extended to any other area which may be mutually beneficial to both the organizations under mutual agreements.

CLAUSE-2: SCOPE OF THE MOU:

1. The budding graduates from the institution's could play a key role in the technological up-gradation, innovations and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that the close co-operation between the two would be of major benefits to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
2. Software Technology Training: The first party will provide the training to the students and faculties of the second party on different technology like Clinical Research , Pharmacovigilance, Clinical Data Management, Medical Writing , Regulatory Affairs , Medical Coding , Bio- Informatics, Ai in Clinical Research & Pharmaceutical Training etc..
3. Skill Development Programs: First party to strength the students of second party on the emerging technologies to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
4. Guest Lectures: First party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the second party on the technology trends and inhouse requirements.
5. Faculty Developed Program: First party to trained the faculties of second party for imparting training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned-sectors, if available.
6. Both parties may obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and license of what's ever nature required for offering the program on the terms specified herein under mutual agreement.
7. There was no financial commitment on the part of second party to enroll the students and faculties for any of the activities by the first party under this MOU.
8. First party would extend the help in providing artifacts such as training records, certificates, to the second party upon a written request from the second party. This information is limited to only the students of second party and at the discretion of first party.
9. In case, second party wants to conduct customized commercial trainings then a separate a agreement can be proposed for such programs with mutually agreed terms.

CLAUSE-5: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTY:

1. It is expressly agreed that First party and Second party are acting under this agreement as independent institution, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be constructed as a partnership. Neither party is authorized to use the other party name to make any representations or use the logo without the intimation of the other party. Neither party will create any obligation or liability or expressed or implied, on behalf of the other party, neither party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreement of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other party, to pledge the other party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other party.
2. Cooperation between both the parties would be extended to additional services like Hackathon, consultancy works, Training program certification which may be mutually beneficial to both the organizations under mutual agreement.
